- Integrity beyond academia
- Establishing and nurturing cultures of integrity in schools around the world
- Discouraging, reducing, and dealing with instance of cheating
- Promoting scholastic and research integrity
- Technology and academic integrity

"Among the challenges we face in promoting and building cultures of integrity is the unfortunate perception that many students believe that what happens at schools and universities is different and disconnected from what happens 'in the real world,'" says ICAI executive director Dr. Teresa Fishman.

"So that we may better understand and articulate the connection between academic integrity and integrity issues in other contexts, presenters will be invited to explore the connections between the work we do with students and ethical issues in the world at large."
